When thoroughly cultivated, this connection helps in healing and regaining a balanced perspective, especially after trauma, but also as part of living a happy, healthier life.

We are a dedicated group of caring individuals who have come together to create a charitable nonprofit organization which will build upon our intuitive understanding of how powerful the relationships between people and dogs can be. We are a registered New York State corporation and IRS 501c3 public

charity.

We’ve been working on this project for a handful of years, but it is only now that we’re in a position to begin offering free overnights and mini-vacations on our property with our amazing dogs to those in need. A significant component of our upcoming capital campaign is to help accrue the funding necessary to build out our amazing property for free use by our guests.”

“Rich was driving from Ithaca to Chicago on a business trip with three of his dogs a while back, trying to get to Route 86/17, and happened upon a ‘for sale’ sign in the hills of Burdett. He asked the dogs if they would mind if they stopped in to say ‘hi’ to the owners and investigate the property, and three hours later they had placed a down payment on the property.
